10 a.m. GUIDED WINTER HIKE IN TULFES

On the trail of nature - Along the Heinrich-Geisler path to the Tulfein Alm

We take the Glungezer gondola lift from Tulfes to the Halsmarter middle station. With snowshoes we walk along the Heinrich-Geisler path, a famous local pioneer in winter sports, crossing the forest to the Tulfein Alm. The view of the Karwendel and Inn Valley is breath-taking! Our hiking guide is a real flora and fauna expert and will inform you about the local wildlife and their habitat. After a delicious lunch in the alpine hut, we walk back to the middle station. If you like it more comfortable, you can return by gondola. Just do it!

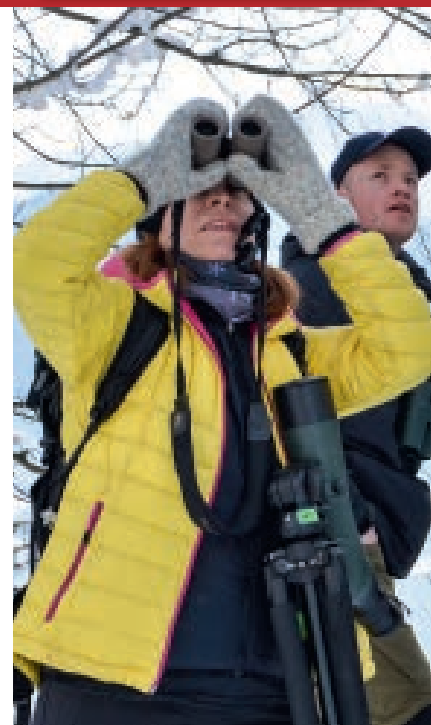

Already in the Middle Ages, Hall was known for its baths, during the 20th century the town was even called Solbad Hall, literally salt bath Hall. Guests from all over the world came into the region to take a cure, to hike and go skiing and profit from various occasions to enjoy nature in summer as well as in winter. At any time, Hall and its surroundings were worth travelling.
